As with all pubs we have had to make certain changes to comply with government guidelines to ensure the safety of our staff and customers. We have taken onboard all aspects of these guidelines and all customers can be confident that their experience at The Black Horse will be professional and controlled at all times. To allow us to control your experience we have put in place the following points which we curiously ask all of our customers to follow. You will be guided through these points on arrival prior to being seated.

- Entry will strictly be via the front door and not the side gates
- We will be restricting numbers at busy times so booking is essential
- Full table service will be in place inside
- An external order point is in place for all food and drink purchases in the garden
- Customers will be required to remain seated. This also applies to children.
- A strict one way system is in place and entry and exit points must be followed
- Seperate toilets for different areas are in place. Please use one in one out system
- Dogs are welcome but must remain on a lead at all times
- Hand sanitiser stations are positioned at multiple points for customers use
- No sitting or standing at the bar
- We have covered outdoor areas and we advise customers to bring blankets for adverse weather conditions
- In line with government guidelines; Name and contact details will be taken when you order
- All of our staff will be having daily health checks

We are working hard to ensure that everyone's safety is at the forefront of our operation, and we expect all customers to follow the above points. Anyone who refuses to adhere to these points will be asked to leave in order to protect our customers and staff.
